WHEREAS:

This City Council has accepted the provisions of Chapter 452 of the Acts of 1943, Chapter 138 of the Acts of 1968, and Chapter 300 of the Acts of 1971, which are now referred to as Section 90A, 90C and 90D respectively of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, and

WHEREAS:

The above referred legislation provides for increases in the retirement allowances of those employees who were retired under this legislation and no increase in compensation has been made since 1972 adjustment which was based on 1971 budget figures, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That this City Manager be and hereby is requested to arrange a meeting with a representative of the Retirement Board, the City Auditor, the City Solicitor, the Director of Budget and Personnel, a representative of the Retired Employees and the members of the Finance Committee of this City Council in order to determine the course of action to be followed in the implementation of this legislation and to further discuss the impact of Chapter 724 of the Acts of 1974 which will take effect on January 1, 1975.
