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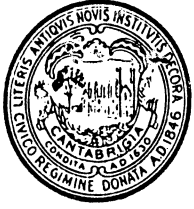

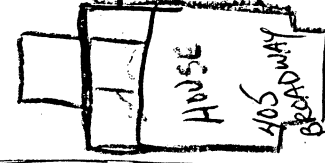

To the Honorable, the City Council of the

City of Cambridge:

The undersigned respectfully request that a driveway for residential use may be constructed and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions:

a) If the application is disapproved, the deposit will be returned to the applicant;

b) If the application is approved, construction of the driveway will not commence until such time as the full amount of the driveway construction cost as estimated by the Department of Public Works, less the \$75 deposit, is paid to the Department of Public Works by a check made out to the "City of Cambridge."
