- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Kathy Spiegelman for her outstanding accomplishments and to further wish her good health, happiness and Godspeed in the years ahead as she considers her future endeavors; and be it further

- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby recognizes Kathy Spiegelman's contribution to the City and wishes her the best in her future endeavors.

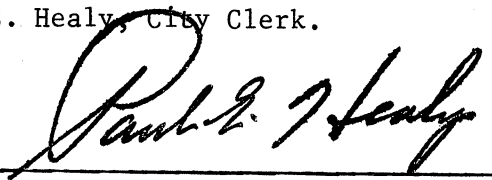
