## An Ordinance in relation to Sinking Funds.

As it is ordained by the City Council of  
the City of Cambridge as follows:-

Sec. 1. The Ordinance in relation to Sinking  
Funds, adopted December 22, 1875, is  
herely amended so that the election  
of Commissioners in the year 1876 shall  
take place on the first Monday of  
January 1876, instead of in April in  
said year, and the Commissioners then  
elected shall hold office for for one,  
two, and three years, respectively, from  
the time of their election and until  
others are elected in their stead, as  
provided in the second section of said  
Ordinance.

Sec. 2. ~~The~~ Said Ordinance is further  
amended by striking out the word "since"  
in the ~~fourth~~ second line of the fourth  
section, ~~thereof~~ and inserting the word  
"after" in place thereof.

Section 3. Said Ordinance is further  
amended by striking out in the tenth  
section thereof the words "except so  
much as relates to the election of  
Commissioners".
