- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Julio C. Felloni, former Chief Pharmacist at the Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Julio was born in Sagamore in 1908 and later graduated from the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy, where he distinguished himself as a disciplined student, and later served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Army; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to his love for his work at the Cambridge Hospital for twenty-one years, Julio also truly enjoyed serving as Chairman and a long time member of the Watertown Board of Health, the town which he called home for some fifty-seven years; and
- WHEREAS: Julio was a long time member of the Democratic Town Committee and was active in veteran's organizations, being the founder and past President of the Amvets Post 14; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Lilyan (Norian) Felloni and to the Felloni family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Felloni on behalf of the entire City Council.

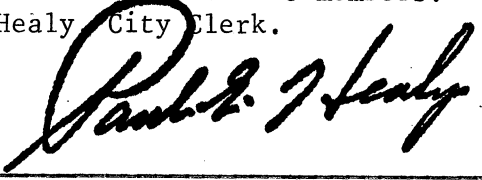
