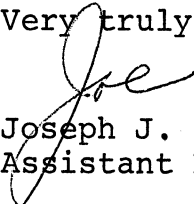

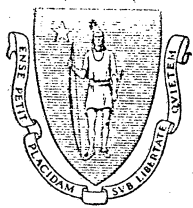

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY- THREE.

AN ACT

relative to the Retirement Allowance
of Julia M. Critchfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the city of Cambridge is hereby authorized to increase the retirement allowance of Julia M. Critchfield, a former employee of the law department of said city, to a sum not exceeding forty-five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city of Cambridge and the increased retirement allowance authorized by section one of this act shall be paid on and after said effective date.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts
in General Court assembled.

The undersigned, citizens of Cambridge, respectfully
