WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Police Sergeant Harold Murphy has been appointed Chief of the Hudson Police Department effective February 2, 1981; and

WHEREAS: Harold is a fifteen (15) year veteran of the Cambridge Police Department having first been appointed in November of 1965 and just ten (10) short years later was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in 1975; and

WHEREAS: Harold who was elected President of the Patrolmen's Association in 1974 holds a bachelor's degree from Northeastern University and a master's degree in Criminal Justice from Boston University; and

WHEREAS: Harold was cited in 1970 for solving a series of twenty-eight housebreaks, again in 1972 for breaking a major narcotics ring and once more in 1977 while off duty, he observed a break in progress and made an arrest of the suspect; and

WHEREAS: Sergeant Harold Murphy is well liked and respected by his peers both in and out of the department for his honesty, sincerity and integrity; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed resolution to Sergeant Harold Murphy on behalf of the entire City Council as he assumes his new position of Chief of Police in Hudson, Massachusetts; and be it further

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere best wishes to "Chief Murphy" and offer our deepest appreciation for a job well done.
