- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Alan Butler, late Director of the Consumer Commission for the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Alan, a 1980 Summa Cum Laude graduate of Northeastern University, served the City and the Commonwealth with great distinction, addressing a multiplicity of consumer problems throughout the years; and
- WHEREAS: Alan served in the first administration of Governor Michael S. Dukakis as an intern within the Governor's Office of Community Services, interacting on a daily basis with a range of people, departments and state agencies; and
- WHEREAS: Alan later worked within the Executive Office of Consumer Affairs, assigned to the Office of Self-Help, where again he dealt with a wide range of consumer issues prior to being appointed to the position of Director of the Cambridge Consumer Commission on February 2, 1981, a position he truly enjoyed and which he provided direction and his assistance to many local residents who had a particular consumer related complaint; and
- WHEREAS: Alan will be missed by his friends and colleagues at both the state and local level, as well as by his family and a host of consumers for whom he fought; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to his personal friend Herbert Van Dam at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Van Dam on behalf of the entire City Council.
