**WHEREAS:**

James E. Mulrey, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge entered the service of the Fire Department on July 20, 1930 and was pensioned on September 28, 1957 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 81A, sub-section A of section 81B of the General Laws and died on August 7, 1983, having served not less than twenty-seven years, two months and eight days; and

**WHEREAS:**

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Ann J. Mulrey, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it


**ORDERED:**

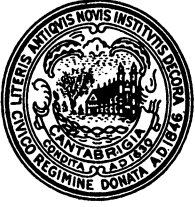
