An Ordinance
in addition to the Ordinance in relation to
Finance.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge:

The Eighth Section of the Ordinance in
relation to Finance, as amended by an Ordinance
passed Sept. 10. 1862, is hereby repealed and the
following section is adopted in place thereof.

Sect. 8. Any sum of money which shall
have been specially appropriated for any
purpose by a vote of the City Council, or which
shall have become due on the principal or inter-
est of any note or other security of the City of Cam-
-bridge, or on any judgment against said City,
may be drawn from the Treasury and paid
by the order of the Mayor without any action on
the part of the Committee on Accounts.
