RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record supporting preference for Cambridge residents in all HUD funded expiring use property in Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record in support of amending the HUD regulations to institute a residency preference for the filling of vacancies for expiring use buildings; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a copy to the entire Massachusetts Congressional delegation, including the soon to be elected Mayor of Somerville, Michael Capuano.
