- WHEREAS: Dominic, a Cambridge native, is a graduate of the Haggerty Grammar School and a 1942 graduate of Rindge Technical High School where he served as a class officer in his Junior and Senior years; and
- WHEREAS: Dominic served his country honorably in the United States Marine Corps during World War II and saw action in the South Pacific with the First Marine Air Wing; and
- WHEREAS: Dominic was appointed to the Cambridge Police Department on March 20, 1950; served as a Detective Sergeant in the Bureau of Criminal Investigations for twenty-one years and was for nine years Assistant Director of the Cambridge Police Academy; and
- WHEREAS: During his career he received thirty-five commendations from City, State, Federal and private organizations and during his forty-two years he served under eleven Police Chiefs before he retired in October, 1991; and
- WHEREAS: Dominic is married to his bride of forty-four years, Teresa, and their lives have been enriched through their children Anthony and Laura and their four grandchildren; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its heartiest congratulations and best wishes to Dominic R. Scalese on the occasion of being named the 1992 Rindge Alumni Man-of-the-Year; and be it further

Dominic R. Scalese was born on Oct. 10, 1924 in Cambridge, Mass. He graduated from the Haggerty Grammar School June 1938. Went to Rindge Technical School and was in the Aeronautical Course. Graduated in June 1942. Dominic was a Class officer in his Junior and Senior year.

Dominic enlisted in the United States Marine Corps October 1942 served in the South Pacific with the First Marine Air Wing and was Honorably discharged in April 1946. He attended Newman Preparatory in Boston and after a stint with the Foundry at BF Goodrich, Watertown Mass. joined the Cambridge Police Department in March 20, 1950. While serving as a Police Officer, he attended College day and nights with semesters at Harvard, Northeastern, Babson, Mass. Bay Community College and in June of 1974 received his degree with many Cambridge Police Officers at Boston College.

During Dominic's Career as a Police Officer, walking routes, twenty one years as a Detective Sergeant in the Bureau of Criminal Investigation and nine years as the Assistant Director of the Cambridge Police Academy. He became a Certified Firearm Instructor and helped develop a Defensive Tactics Program with the Mass. Criminal Justice Training Council. He is a certified Defensive Tactics Instructor.

During his career with the Cambridge Police Department he worked under eleven Police Chiefs. Dominic has received about thirtyfive commendations from the Cambridge Police Department, Governors, Attorney Generals, District Attorneys, Judges and Justices from District Courts and Superior Courts, Metropolitan District Commissioners, United States Army, the United States Marine Corps, many Veterans Organizations, and others from many Law Enforcement Agencies including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Secret Service, ATF, City of Cambridge Officials and citizens, and Religious Organizations. Department of Public Safety State Police and also Traveled to Germany and Italy on Homicide cases. Dominic retired from the Cambridge Police Department in October 1991. Dominic is presently directing his own Private Detective Agency in Cambridge and is also a Constable with the City of Cambridge.

Dominic, and his wife Teresa, married 44 years Oct. 3, has a son Anthony and two grandsons, and a Daughter Laura and two granddaughters.

Dominic has three brothers also graduates from Rindge Tech. Vincent and Fred Class of 1940 and Anthony Class of 1947.
