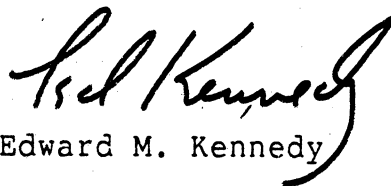
I wanted to write to let you know that I have received your recent correspondence. I know this matter is of concern to you, and I sincerely hope I can be of some assistance.
