COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

- WHEREAS: We strongly urge that the United States cut off all military aid and training to Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador which consistently violate human rights; and
- WHEREAS: We urge the cessation of covert actions by the United States seeking to topple dually formed governments which have a different philosophy than ours, but which do not pose an immediate threat to the United States security; and
- WHEREAS: We support granting political asylum to refugees from those Central American countries pursuing policies of repression; and
- WHEREAS: We support aiding the efforts of neutral countries such as Mexico, to help bring about negotiated settlements when possible; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward copies of this resolutions to United States Senators Paul Tsongas and Edward Kennedy, as well as to Speaker Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr.

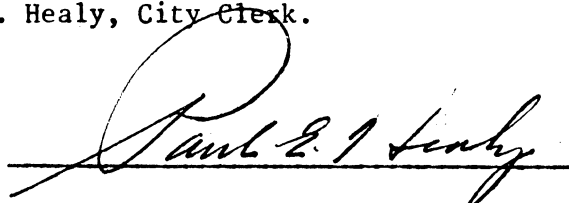

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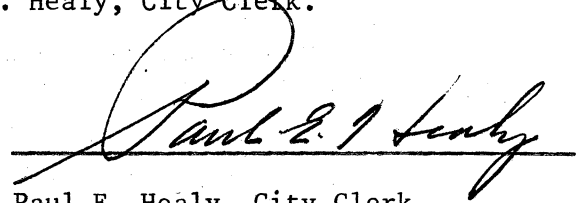
