Margarita Otero-Alvarez, principal of the Longfellow School, has been selected to participate in the National Hispana Leadership Institute 1997 Fellowship Program.

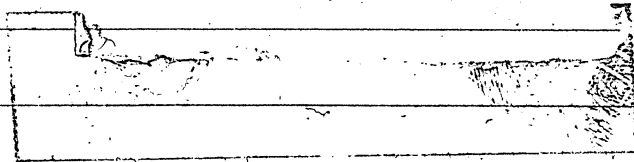
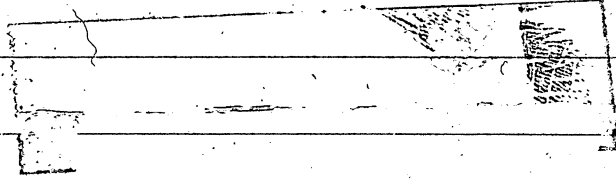
The NHLI is a comprehensive, four-week program, which includes one week at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and another week at the Center for Creative Leadership in San Francisco. Two additional weeks of training are held in California and Washington, D.C.

Otero-Alvarez said she hopes to implement the newly gained information at Longfellow. "I hope that what I learn there can be brought back and implemented into good educational practices at the Longfellow," she said.

To date, more than 200 Hispanic women have graduated from the national program. "We are very proud of Margarita and this tremendous honor," said School Superintendent Mary Lou McGrath. "She's been an important leader in our school system, and is a terrific role model, not only for young Hispanic women, but for all young women."
