Parking lot behind the Cambridge Savings
Bank at 1960 Mass Avenue.

The Bank officials Ron Kennelly, Peter Rattigan and Maureen Gilpatrick, were contacted and informed about the disturbance caused by the use of the parking lot during evening hours.

The Bank officials informed us that after 5:00 p.m., the staff from the Masonic Temple located at 1950 Mass Avenue use the parking lot.

I was informed by Maureen Gilpatrick from the Savings Bank, that after meeting with the neighbors and the Masonic Temple staff it was agreed that there will be no parking after 10:30 p.m..

At the request of the neighbor, we have made the bank to move trash dumpster to the corner of the property away from the residential use.

We would periodically monitor this location for compliance of the agreement.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

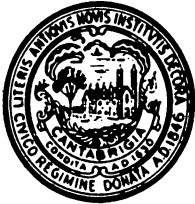
