

Dear Mayor Russell;

We, the residents and homeowners of Saint Paul Street and Prospect Street, are writing to express our concern about the proposed shelter in the Prospect Street Congregational Church. We have spoken with Mr. Whittie and members of the board of Shelter, Inc. and understand the need for a long term shelter. However, we feel that our neighborhood can not support another shelter/community residence. We are on the border of three areas which have thirteen of the sixteen known shelters/community residences in Cambridge. Our area alone, area six, supports six community residences. In addition, we are faced with extensive commercial development in the CARD district and with the sale of the Gas Company building and its lots.

We respectfully request that you listen to and consider our concerns when we come before you on June 10, 1985.
