M. to 11:00 P. M. on July 12, from 7:00 P. M. to 11:00 P. M. on July 13, and from 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P. M. on July 14, 1974 for the purpose of holding a religious festival, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works and the Chief of Police provide for the safe passage of the parade on the following streets: from Springfield Street to Cambridge Street to Warren Street to Marion Street and returning from Marion Street to Cambridge Street to Springfield Street to the Portuguese American Civic League headquarters, and be it further

ORDERED:

That a copy of this order be sent to the City Manager, the Director of Traffic and Parking, the Chief of Police and the Department of Recreation with the request that they make the necessary arrangements within their respective departments to comply with the intent of this order.
