WHEREAS:

The safety of neighborhood residents in the Gore Street area has been jeopardized by speeding vehicles and excessive traffic from McGrath O'Brien Highway, trailer truck traffic to the Miller River storage facility, and the outpouring of traffic from Twin City Mall; and

WHEREAS:

Gore Street is an intensely populated neighborhood with residential housing, a substantial number of children as well as the Lambert Street Elderly Housing residents and is also an area which attracts other area residents and children to its neighborhood playground; and

WHEREAS:

In recent years there have been too many instances of children being struck by cars, speeding violations, car doors being sheared off and other damage to parked vehicles; now therefore be it

ORDERED:

That Gore Street be made a one way street from McGrath O'Brien Highway to the Somerville line.
