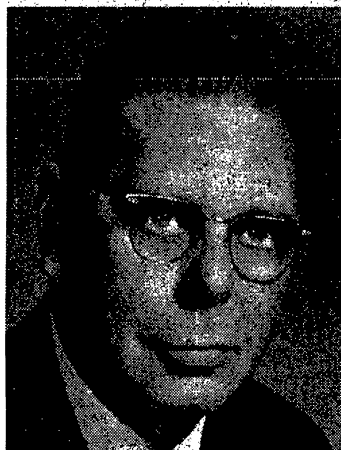

PAUL SISKIND

Paul Siskind, 86; ex-dean at BU Law

Paul M. Siskind, a former dean of Boston University Law School and chairman of UST Corp., died Monday in Newton-Wellesley Hospital. He was 86.

Mr. Siskind was born in Lawrence. He graduated from Dartmouth College and New York University Law School.

After serving in the Army during World War II, he joined the faculty of Boston University in 1946. He was dean of the law school from 1966 until 1976 and remained a professor at the school until 1989.

He was an assistant attorney general under Edward J. McCormack and was a member of the commission that drew up the state's ethics and conflict-of-interest code.

For 27 years, until retiring in 1994, he was chairman of UST Corp., the parent company of US Trust and its operations in Massachusetts and Connecticut.

He leaves his wife, Leona (Marks); two daughters, Judith A. of Coral Gables, Fla., and Ellen C. of Silver Spring, Md.; a sister, Jean Ellowitch of Lake Worth, Fla.; and four grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 10:30 a.m. tomorrow in Temple Shalom in Newton.
