

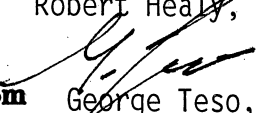

Subject City Council order #44 & #47 Re: "Right Turn Only" sign at Technology Sq. & Broadway

The Traffic and Parking Department along with other city agencies met with the developers of Tech Square at the time of the proposed construction of their garage at Broadway and Portland Street. At these meetings, the main discussion was the safe circulation of traffic entering and exiting the garage. It was agreed by all parties that the left turns from the garage onto Broadway were and still are very dangerous movements.

It was also determined that all traffic wanting to make a left turn onto Broadway would be directed to exit onto Portland Street and make the left turn at the traffic signal at Portland and Broadway. This circulation plan provides the safest movement for traffic out of the garage.

This restriction was part of the mitigating measures that were agreed to by the city and the developer.

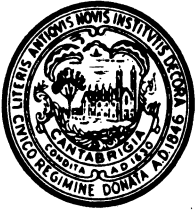

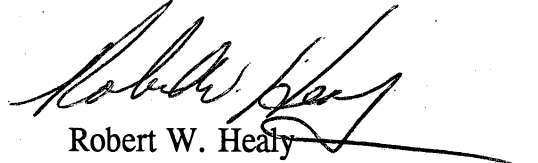
