Energy Management Committee

Last fall you initiated an Energy Management Program for the City (see attached memo dated November 20, 1979). The Energy Management Committee met on December 13th to begin a coordinated planning process. Accomplishments to date include: establishing energy as a separate cost center in each departmental budget, recording energy use in each building, and beginning to perform energy audits.

In the near future I plan to implement a computer-based energy use data system. The system will track energy use by building with data supplied by the utility companies. This system will enable us to prioritize energy improvements. In further response to the Council Order, I am preparing a report detailing our present and future energy management program. The report will be completed by July 1st.

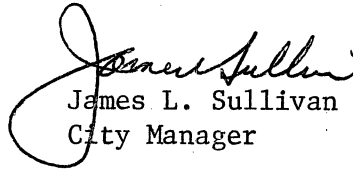
