- (1) The Cambridge Rescue responded to 4,357 calls in the calendar year 1979.
- (2) Of that number, 2,432 were non-fire-related calls.
- (3) On a non-fire-related emergency, the fire alarm operator uses the discretion of his office. A Deputy Chief is always available to guide Fire Alarm.

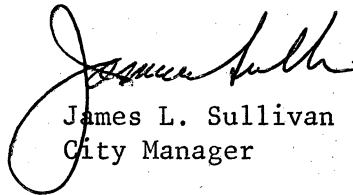
