WHEREAS:

On November 4, 1983, the Governor signed chapter 470 of the Acts of 1983, popularly known as the "Right to Know Law", and on June 28, 1984 implementing regulations were published in the Massachusetts Register, effective September 26, 1984; and

WHEREAS:

The new law and regulations require the City Manager to appoint a "municipal coordinator", who is to have certain important discretionary powers; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager report in writing to the City Council as soon as possible:

1. The name of the Cambridge municipal coordinator.
2. For which employers and substances the municipal coordinator proposed to exercise his or her power under 310 CMR 33.03(2) to require filing of a "material safety data sheet" (MSDS).
3. In particular, for which substances, if any, the municipal coordinator proposed to request MSDS's from Arthur D. Little Inc. and W.R. Grace & Co.
