WHEREAS: Adelaide began and taught for more than a decade the seminar "International Education and the UN: a Colloquium" at Teacher's College, Columbia University; and

WHEREAS: Adelaide's research formed her work, a book issued by the UN called "*World Concerns and the United Nations: Teaching Units for Primary, Secondary and Teacher Education*" which was a best-seller for the UN; and
