- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Genoeffa Parente Manganello, born in Serra, Avellino, Italy in 1892; and
- WHEREAS: Genoeffa, with her family left their homeland via Naples, Italy and immigrated to America in 1912, arriving in New York and went immediately to West Pittston, Pennsylvania, remaining there until 1916 when they moved to Cambridge, where throughout the years Genoeffa nurtured her relationship with friends and relatives who often referred to her as the "Matchmaker" for the many times she would introduce people to each other; and
- WHEREAS: Genoeffa has long been a faithful follower of the Christian Assembly Church since she had a continuous desire to be in prayer and to walk with the Lord daily; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mr. Vincenzo Manganello and to the entire Manganello family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Vincenzo Manganello on behalf of the entire City Council.
