WHEREAS:

The Charles Riverfront between M.I.T. and Peabody Terrace is largely undeveloped or underdeveloped; and

WHEREAS:

The Riverfront has been subject to intense development pressures in recent years as evidenced by the 808 Memorial Drive project and the Hyatt Hotel, and by pending development discussions with respect to the Riverside Press site and the Treeland-Bindery site; and

WHEREAS:

In the absence of alternative uses, the Riverfront is destined to become a wall of high density, high rise construction; and

WHEREAS:

The Riverfront represents the last--and rapidly dwindling-- opportunity to acquire and develop a large open space resource in the eastern half of the City comparable to the open space resources available to residents of western Cambridge; and

WHEREAS:

The City, the Commonwealth, the Regional agencies are expending huge sums of money in an effort to clean up the Charles River; and

WHEREAS:

These State and Regional agencies have expressed interest in expanding public landholdings along the Charles River; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to order the Planning and Development Department to develop a comprehensive, long range land acquisition and open space development plan for the Charles Riverfront, especially the Riverside Press.
