

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, April 12. 1865.

Whereas a private way in Ward Five, called Orchard Street, has heretofore been devoted to the public use by the owners of the adjoining lands, and is now in a fit condition to become a public highway, -

And Whereas it is adjudged by the aldermen and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that said street be laid out as a public highway, and that no person will be damaged thereby, or be entitled to any compensation from the City: - therefore

Ordered, That said private way be and hereby is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Orchard Street; agreeably to a Plan thereof drawn by W. A.allas and W. S. Perkins, bearing date of June, 1864, and now on file in the office of the City Clerk, to run from Beach Street to Dover Street, the same to be forty feet in width, as shown and stated on said Plan.
