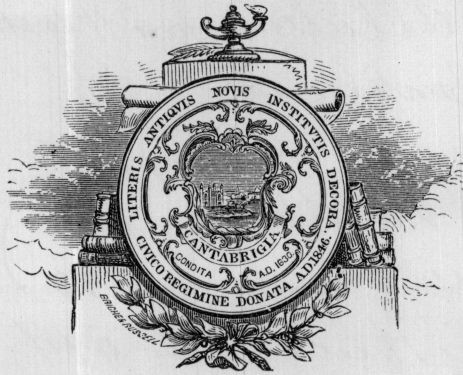


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen,

Dec. 4, 1872,

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Dublin Street
be widened

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *both sides of*
Dublin Street

as is included between the *red* lines shown on a plan of *Dublin*
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *Dec. 3, 1872* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Dublin*
Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:
