After surveying the property located at 57 Fulkerson Street owned by Mr. Edward DiPierro, I have found that trucks using the driveway adjacent to Mr. DiPierro's property are causing damage to his home.

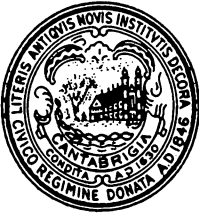
After watching these trucks backing into this driveway, it was our opinion that all the damage occurred within the private property of the Boston Metal Products. The Traffic Department then met with Mr. DiPierro and the manager of the Boston Metal Products Company and suggested that the Boston Metal Products install on their property along Mr. DiPierro's (3) three property (7) seven inch diameter pipes four (4) feet high filled with concrete to protect the house from damage caused by these trucks.

Both parties agreed that this would solve their problem and as soon as the weather permits the Boston Metal Products will install these pipes.
