- WHEREAS: The current statewide public safety system has failed to get accident victims proper assistance in crucial situations; and
- WHEREAS: The effectiveness of the system has aroused significant concern; and
- WHEREAS: The Senate has passed Bill S-390 (E-911) to rectify these deficiencies; and
- WHEREAS: An enhanced 911 service would establish a state-of-the-art emergency response system for all citizens and improved communications services for the handicapped; and
- WHEREAS: Bill S-390 is currently stalled in the House Ways and Means Committee in the House of Representatives; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council urges House Representatives Flaherty, Thompson, and Vellucci to support Bill S-390; and further be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to be sent to Representatives Flaherty, Thompson, and Vellucci.
