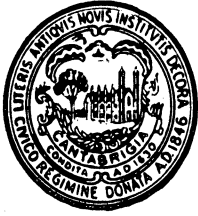

The public notice reprinted on the reverse side of this memorandum appeared in the Cambridge Chronicle of October 11, 1984. The basis for the notice is the new Block Grant Program legislation enacted by Congress on November 30, 1983 (P.L. No. 98-181) requiring that a grantee "shall make copies of the performance report available to its citizens in sufficient time to permit the citizens to comment on the report prior to its submission to HUD", and that "each recipient may determine the specific manner and times the report will be made available to citizens consistent with the preceeding sentence."

The Grantee Performance Report to be made available for citizen review and comment on October 15th will be presented in the new format established by HUD last year. This is a "stream-lined" format that reports the year's CDBG accomplishments on a consolidated basis, rather than neighborhood by neighborhood. We will prepare our own expanded report per the latter format, for general distribution, during the fall.

As stated in the Chronicle public notice, comments on the "HUD Grantee Performance Report" received by Friday, October 19th at the closing time will be transmitted to HUD with our official transmittal of the report on Monday, October 22nd.

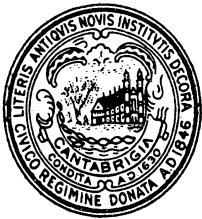
