To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$8,359.66 in the Public Investment Fund of the Department of Human Services Extraordinary Expenditures Account. The Cambridge Partnership, through CEOC, has awarded the Department of Human Services funds for capital improvements for the King Preschool. Funds are awarded to centers for the purpose of classroom improvements to maintain accreditation. The King Preschool has successfully achieved accreditation and will be up for renewal in the spring of 2000.
