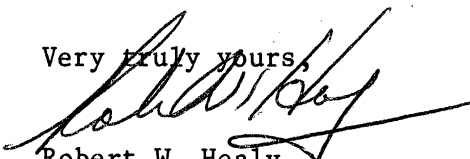

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 39, regarding the deployment of foot patrol personnel into areas experiencing higher crime presence, a report from the Police Department indicates that arrests made on July 31, 1989 and August 29, 1989 will result in a marked decline in the amount of housebreaks in Cambridgeport and mid-Cambridge. The two persons arrested are responsible for many breaks in these areas.

Additionally, a greater number of walking routes are being filled for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., on a daily basis.
