- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Housing Authority presented a Comprehensive Modernization Program for Washington Elms to the Washington Elms Tenants Council on June 5, 1980; and
- WHEREAS: The Washington Elms Tenants Council immediately reactivated itself into a body of informed and responsible residents representing its neighbors in the development; and
- WHEREAS: The Washington Elms Tenants Council met regularly to formulate sensitive and complex recommendations for the Comprehensive Modernization Program; and
- WHEREAS: The Washington Elms Tenants Council will continue to participate in deliberations about the Program; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council commend the Washington Elms Tenants Council for its vital role in formulating a Comprehensive Modernization Program which has led to the application for 8.6 million dollars from HUD to further this pioneer effort in revitalizing a public housing development; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Washington Elms Tenants Council on behalf of the entire City Council.
