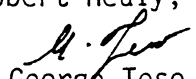

Subject City Council Order #7 & #32 of Oct. 16, 1989 concerning speeding on Oxford St.

The Traffic Department is working with the Police Department to enforce the existing speed limit on Oxford Street and is conducting accident and speed studies along this road to determine reasons for speeding and causes of accidents and find remedies for these violations.

The existing speed limit is 25 MPH and our initial investigation led us to decide that more warning signs were needed and that an overhead warning beacon be installed at the intersection of Forest Street and Oxford Street.

We have installed more signs and are going out to bid to install the overhead warning beacon.
