Detectives who have followed up on these crimes have found no evidence of forced entry in any of these crimes. Small amounts of cash missing in each inc

The two larcenies in the building were in a different apartment from the breaks. In both incidents the victim believes his roommate was the suspect. The two street robberies were in the lobby and may be part of a pattern involving strong arm robberies of the elderly around Central Square, which has been quiet over the past month.

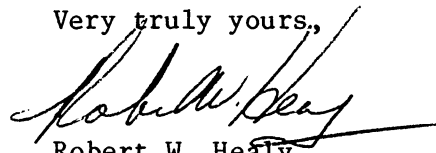
