- WHEREAS: Mary E. McMorrow has retired from the service of the Cambridge Public Library after forty-eight years of employment, beginning on October 11, 1937; and
- WHEREAS: During those 48 years she has given devoted service to the library as Circulation Librarian, building rapport between the library and its patrons, and promoting the best of personalized and individualized service; and
- WHEREAS: As Head of Circulation Services, she successfully brought the library into the technological age with the computerized circulation system while retaining and reinforcing the role of service to the patrons, and working for the success of library programming; now, therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That this Cambridge City Council pays tribute to and bestows honor upon Mary E. McMorrow; and be it further
- ORDERED: That this City Council dedicate the Circulation Area of the Main Library to Mary E. McMorrow for Meritorious Service to the Cambridge Public Library, and that the Director of the Library make the necessary arrangements for the purchasing, placing in appropriate location, and dedication of a plaque, stating the above, at the Main Library of the Cambridge Public Library.
