Coordination of Trucking Schedules

Date: June 24, 1994

In response to this Council Order we have used our Neighborhood Planning Component for information as to any currently known instances where companies have coordinated their trucking schedules with community needs. In addition, the License Commission was also contacted to see if any truck restrictions were implemented as part of their regulatory process.

This effort only identified two instances where companies have restricted their truck activity during certain times of the day. One is the Star Market on Mount Auburn Street where the License Commission was able to negotiate an agreement to limit delivery times and the other is the Wise Potato Chip Distributing Company on Rindge Avenue in North Cambridge where the business volunteered as a "good neighbor policy" to restrict all truck activity during the time when children are going to and from school.
