WHEREAS: DAVID NUNES, son of Tony and Gail Nunes, was an active part of the life of the city, a much missed member of the Cambridge Youth Soccer League, Little League Baseball, the Cambridge Performance Project, and several other Cambridge youth activities; and

WHEREAS: His neighbors feel a great loss as a result of his passing, and have therefore requested that the City of Cambridge honor DAVID NUNES' memory; and

WHEREAS: DAVID NUNES spent much of his brief but full life playing in the old Morse Park on Putnam Avenue between Brookline and Pearl Streets; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council hereby proclaims that either the aforementioned park shall be renamed DAVID NUNES PARK, or that some suitable location in DAVID NUNES' neighborhood, to be determined by Mayor Reeves, interested members of the Council and the Department of Public Works, shall be renamed DAVID NUNES SQUARE, so that all of the City might remember this wonderful child who was taken from us too soon.
