Recommending that Forest St.
be accepted when the petitioners therefor ~~for~~
shall have furnished a plan and profile of
said street showing it to be forty feet in
width, free from all encroachments, except as
hereinafter mentioned, and graded to the accept-
ance of the Supt. of Streets; And when
Oliver B. Campbell shall have removed
the Barn and Fence now encroaching upon
the line And shall have executed a release to the
City of the land cover^d by the present build-
ings, reserving the right to maintain his dwelling
house as it now stands, until he shall see fit
to remove the same, or until the City shall
remove it by due process of law,
