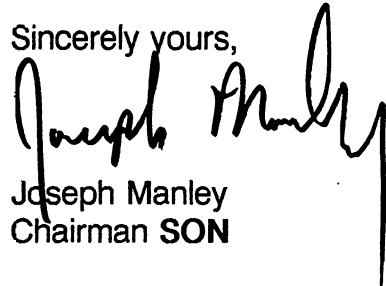

Dear Mr. Healy:

I am writing in response to Council Order Number 08 dated 4/26/93 regarding a communication from Joseph Manley relative to the proposed modernization and expansion of The Cambridge Hospital. Prior to addressing Mr. Manley's specific issues, I would like to provide an update on our discussions with the hospital's neighbors regarding our building plans. The Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association and The City/Hospital have reached agreement on the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which will insure that the needs of the hospital will be balanced with the interests of our neighbors. This is a precedent setting agreement between a large municipal institution and its neighbors of which we are very proud. The MOU is being sent to the City Council in this packet for the Monday, May 17, 1993 meeting separately. While two Somerville neighbors have worked with the Community Advisory Committee that has negotiated this agreement, negotiations with the Somerville neighbors will clearly entail much more work before agreement is reached with them. I am however encouraged in that active dialogue between Mr. Manley and me has commenced with two meetings within the past week and active discussions with a broader group of Somerville neighbors will hopefully commence in two to three weeks.

Regarding Mr. Manley's assertion that the hospital has contradicted itself relative to our plans, this simply is not the case. Mr. Manley's reference to articles in local newspapers comparing isolated quotations to statements in our Determination of Need (DON) application is inaccurate and misleading. Our proposed Facility Plan, which will clearly be modified as we go forward particularly as a result of the neighborhood process we have agreed to with the MCNA, has been clearly articulated in our DON and in public meetings. We have repeatedly been recognized by the parties we are working with for our forthright presentation of the facts.

I am pleased that Mr. Manley is now meeting with me to address his concerns. He has requested information regarding the project which we are compiling and we will continue to share with him all appropriate information necessary. I am convinced that with a clear and open dialogue between the hospital and its Somerville neighbors, a process similar to the one reached with the MCNA will be reached so that communications such as this council order can be avoided in the future.
