Application of VarTec Telecom, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Applicant, a corporation organized under the laws of Texas, plans to offer residential and business service from points of origin within Massachusetts to points of termination within Massachusetts. All services will be available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week, 365 days per year.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before April 28, 1994.

The petitioner, VarTec Telecom, Inc., is required to complete the following: (1) Give notice by publication hereof once, on or before April 14, 1994 [which is twenty-one (21) days prior to May 5, 1994], in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram; (2) Give notice by mailing a copy hereof on or before April 14, 1994 to the Local Exchange and Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list; and (3) Make return of service and publication no later than May 12, 1994.
