} In Board of Aldermen

Ordered - That the City Clerk cause the amended Ordinance in relation to Streets to be posted in the principal streets of the City forthwith

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, March 10. 1863.

Whereas there are certain streets in the City which have become public ways by dedication, before the passage of the Ordinance relating to the laying out and acceptance of streets, August 26. 1851. which streets are not of the width required by said Ordinance, and therefore cannot be accepted,

Ordered, That the Committee on Ordinances be instructed to consider and report whether any amendment is required in the Ordinance in relation to streets.
