COUNCILLOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: Plans for development at W.R. Grace are proceeding, and additional traffic will clearly be generated; and
- WHEREAS: With the opening of the Alewife station, residents on neighboring streets are already feeling the impact of cars cutting through their streets; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to have a thorough traffic study of the neighborhoods north and east of the W.R. Grace site initiated to determine whether a reconfiguration of traffic patterns would provide better protection for the streets in those neighborhoods; and be it further
- ORDERED: That thorough public input be insured before any changes are made; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager determine whether such a study requires funding over and above the Traffic Department budget and that he recommend such funding, if necessary, through the developer, grant funds, or the City budget process.
