- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be advised that it shall be the policy of this City Council that the appointment of a representative of the elderly tenants of Cambridge Public Housing be established. When and if a vacancy occurs on the Housing Authority Board that it shall be filled by a representative of elderly tenants in Public Housing who shall be identified through an election process; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager designate the Department of Human Services the responsibility to plan, develop, and oversee an election among all elderly public housing tenants. The election process shall draw upon the resources of a variety of organizations concerned with the quality of life of the elderly in Cambridge including, but not limited to, Committee on Elders, Council on Aging and Tenant Services; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That upon completion of the election, a list containing the names of the three candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be submitted to the appointing authority who then will make a recommendation to the City Council for confirmation; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That a record of process be kept of all "that takes place" and that a report of the entire process be made available to members of the City Council in order to insure that all was on the "up and up".
