In City Council,

June 2, 1931.

ORDERED:-

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining of signs, the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Rotary Club of Cambridge for the erection of six post signs on the sidewalk at the following locations:-

1. Magazine Street near Memorial Drive
2. Massachusetts Avenue near Memorial Drive
3. Main Street at Broadway
4. Bridge Street at Cambridge Line
5. Massachusetts Avenue at Arlington Line
6. Mt. Auburn Street at Watertown Line.

The distance from the bottom of the signs to the sidewalk is to be eight feet and the exact location of said signs is to be approved by the Superintendent of Streets.

Provided that before erecting the above named signs the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said signs.
