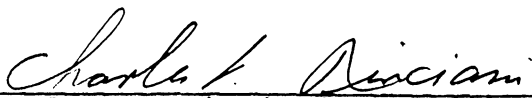
Perambulation of the Boundary Line

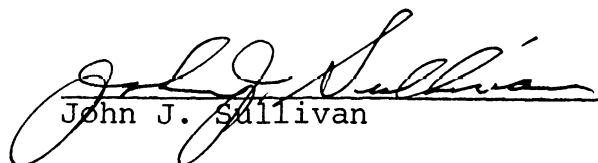

The City of Cambridge and the Town of Arlington

On October 28, 1986, the undersigned Charles F. Rinciari and John J. Sullivan having been duly authorized by the Arlington Board of Selectmen to locate and mark the monuments designating the Arlington Town Line, did perambulate the boundary line between Arlington and Cambridge and found the monuments marking the Town Line in proper positions and properly marked or as noted below:

1. Corner of Arlington, Belmont and Cambridge within the location lines of Route 2 witnessed by the bound on the Arlington-Cambridge line, 96.42' northerly. (This witness bound was not available for viewing as it was removed or covered during the Route 2 reconstruction.)
2. Corner of Arlington and Cambridge within the location lines of Route 2 located about 300' southwesterly of the intersection of Littlejohn St. and Dorothy Rd. (No bound)
3. Corner of Arlington and Cambridge on the center line of the new channel of Alewife Brook witnessed by the old witness monument marked "A.C.", 127.54' southeasterly. (Witness monument paint marked 1986)
4. Corner of Arlington, Cambridge and Somerville on the center line of the new channel of Alewife Brook, witnessed by a stone monument marked "C.S. 23", on the Cambridge-Somerville boundary line, 318' southeasterly. (Witness monument paint marked 1986)
