- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that several businesses in and around the Binney Street/Fulkerson Street area are experiencing difficulty with the one-way traffic pattern recently implemented; and
- WHEREAS: The business establishments, along with the neighboring community are substantial taxpayers and deserve consideration in any plan to change traffic patterns; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to review the one-way traffic pattern on Binney Street and to report back to this City Council any recommendations for alleviating this problem, after consultation with both the business and residential community.
