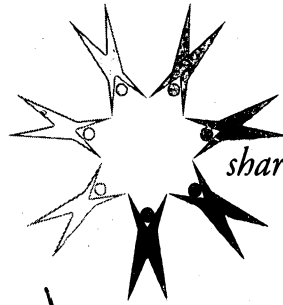

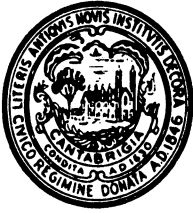

In response to Council Order Number 14, dated April 8, 1996, regarding providing youth programs with the Corporal Burns Shelter for meetings, storage and other purposes, the City, acting through the combined effort of the Community Development, Human Services and Public Works Departments, will be initiating a feasibility study of the entire Corporal Burns site. The scope of the study, with a comprehensive community process, will include an analysis of the current conditions and potential uses of the building, totlot, court surfaces and site amenities with a projected scope of work and related budget. The first community meeting is scheduled for June 12, 1996.

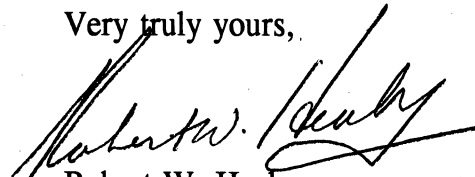
